



RESOLUTION NO. 11-02-02

A RESOLUTION OF THE BOARD OF SUPERVISORS OF GILA COUNTY, ARIZONA, DISSOLVING THE STRAWBERRY HOLLOW COUNTY IMPROVEMENT DISTRICT.

WHEREAS, the Gila County Board of Supervisors received petitions for the vacating of public roadways within the Strawberry Hollow Subdivision, Phase I & II, which conformed to the requirements of *Arizona Revised Statutes §28-6701 & 28-7206*; and

WHEREAS, the roadways within the Strawberry Hollow Subdivision were not necessary for public use as a roadway pursuant to *Arizona Revised Statutes § 28-7202*; and

WHEREAS, the Board of Supervisors accepted the petitions and adopted Resolution No. 09-06-03 on June 23, 2009, vacating the public roadways within the Strawberry Hollow Subdivision, Phase I & II to the Strawberry Hollow Property Owner's Association; and

WHEREAS, the public roadways vacated to the Strawberry Hollow Property Owner's Association contained all of the improvements of the Strawberry Hollow County Improvement District; and

WHEREAS, pursuant to A.R.S. § 48-908, the Board of Supervisors is deemed to be the Board of Directors of the Strawberry Hollow County Improvement District; and

WHEREAS, all bonds and other obligations of the Strawberry Hollow County Improvement District are paid or have become barred by the statute of limitations;

WHEREAS, the operation and maintenance functions of the Strawberry Hollow County Improvement District or the major part thereof have been taken over by the Strawberry Hollow Property Owner's Association,

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF SUPERVISORS OF GILA COUNTY, ARIZONA:

1. That by virtue of the authority set forth in *Arizona Revised Statutes § 48-959*, the Strawberry Hollow County Improvement District is hereby dissolved;

2. That the Clerk of the Board file with the Department of Property Valuation, State of Arizona and with the County Assessor of Gila County, a certified copy of this resolution.
