

## **PUBLIC NOTICE**

**PUBLIC NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN** that the Gila County Board of Supervisors will hold a public hearing at the Gila County Courthouse, 1400 East Ash Street, Globe, Arizona, and simultaneously broadcast to the Payson Board of Supervisors' Conference Room at the County Complex, 610 E. Highway 260, Payson, Arizona to consider adopting Ordinance No. 11-02, which amends Ordinance No. 98-01 – Open Outdoor Fires by including language regarding fireworks. The hearing will take place at 10:00 a.m. on Tuesday, June 28, 2011. The proposed changes are as follows:

Add Definition 1.5 to state:

- 1.5 Fireworks means any combustible or explosive composition, substance or combination of substances, or any article prepared for the purpose of producing a visible or audible effect by combustion, explosion, deflagration or detonation, that is a consumer firework or display firework as defined by A.R.S. §36-1601 (3) a.

Amend Prohibition 2.1 to state:

- 2.1 At any time when the United States Department of Agriculture, United States Forest Service, issues an order under Title 36, Section 261.52 of the Code of Federal Regulations placing certain restrictions on fires within Tonto National Forest, it shall be unlawful for any person to build, maintain, attend, ignite or use an open fire, bonfire, campfire or fireworks, except as provided in this Section.
