AN ORDINANCE OF THE GILA COUNTY BOARD OF SUPERVISORS

THE BOARD OF SUPERVISORS FOR GILA COUNTY, ARIZONA FINDS THAT:

1. It is necessary to preserve the public health, safety and welfare of all Gila County residents by amending our current regulations.
2. This ordinance shall amend Section 4 of the Gila County Building Code Ordinance.

AN ORDINANCE OF GILA COUNTY TO AMEND SECTION 4 OF THE GILA
COUNTY BUILDING CODE ORDINANCE, AS FOLLOWS:

SECTION 4. ADVISORY AND APPEALS BOARD

G. Appeals

4. (amend sentence) ~~Upon receipt of a Notice of Appeal, and after posting of public notice as required, the~~ The Advisory and Appeals Board shall hold a public hearing ~~of the~~ for an appeal within fifteen (15) DAYS OF RECEIPT OF THE Notice of Appeal. (add) Public notice of the hearing shall be posted seven (7) days prior to the hearing date.

10. (add sentence) The Board may request that the County Attorney or Deputy County Attorney be present at appeal hearings.
