Today's CSA Board meeting included a presentation from Coconino County Supervisor Liz Archuleta on the Arizona Secure Rural Schools Coalition Action Team, an alliance of local elected officials committed to advocating for a long-term extension of Secure Rural Schools in the fiscal year 2012 federal budget. Attached is a press release announcing the Action Team and a letter from Supervisor Archuleta and Yavapai County School Superintendent Tim Carter, who are serving as team co-chairs.

Supervisor Archuleta has requested that counties designate one supervisor to serve on the Action Team. This supervisor would be responsible for participating in Action Team meetings and attending advocacy meetings with key members of the congressional delegation.
