





SUBJECT: University of Arizona Insurance Coverage

This document is written to describe the insurance coverage provided to the University of Arizona by the State of Arizona Risk Management program. The coverage described in this memorandum is statutory for state agencies, including Arizona's state university system.

The University of Arizona and its employees, officers, and agents are insured against loss under the provisions of Arizona Revised Statutes §41-621 *et seq.* This coverage also extends to volunteers working under the University's direction and control, and to student interns, externs, residents and fellows enrolled in University training programs.

The applicable wording of this statute is as follows:

A.R.S. §41-621A.3. - The Department of Administration shall obtain insurance against loss, to the extent it is determined necessary and in the best interests of the state on the following:...(3) The state and its departments, agencies, boards and commissions and all officers, agents and employees thereof, and such others as may be necessary to accomplish the functions or business of the state against liability for acts or omissions of any nature while acting in authorized governmental or proprietary capacities and in the course and scope of employment or authorization except as prescribed by this chapter.

The State of Arizona meets this coverage obligation through a combination of self-insurance and purchased commercial insurance. Workers' Compensation coverage for state employees is self-insured in accordance with other provisions of the above statute.

This program is administered by the Arizona Department of Administration, Risk Management Division. The University of Arizona Department of Risk Management and Safety coordinates this function at the university level.
