



AMENDMENT NO. 2

The following amendments are hereby incorporated into the contract documents for the below stated project:

CONTRACT 070712 ELECTRICAL SERVICE UPGRADE PAYSON SHERIFF'S OFFICE BURDEN ELECTRIC

On July 07, 2012, Gila County put out Informal Bid Request No. 070712 for the Electrical Service Upgrade to the Payson Sheriff's Office. The IFB was sent to six electrical contractors in the Globe and Payson areas. The IFB specified a mandatory pre-bid meeting on August 02, 2012. The Bid Submittal date was 08-10-12. The only contractor that attended the mandatory pre-bid meeting was Burden Electric, consequently, Burden Electric was the only contractor to submit a proposal for IFB No. 070712.

On August 03, 2012, Amendment No. 1 was issued, which changed the Bid Submittal due date to August 13, 2012 and removed the requirement for a Contract Performance Bond and a Contract Labor and Material Bond.

On August 09, 2012, Addendum No. 2 was issued, which changed the Bid Submittal due date to August 14, 2012 and specified changes in the Electrical Drawings originally issued. The changes were to include new tower and conex box grounding in the scope of work. Bidders were advised to include the changes in their bid.

On August 10, 2012, Addendum No. 3 was issued, which addressed questions for clarification, regarding grounding for the Radio Tower.

On August 13, 2012, Addendum No. 4 was issued, which addressed questions for clarification, regarding bonding for the tower legs to the grounding ring and the tinned wire that was specified by Bridgers & Paxton.

On August 14, 2012, Burden Electric submitted a proposal in the amount of \$52,544.00. This included the grounding to the Conex box using manufacturer "Square D" material. Burden Electrical also submitted a proposal at that time that included grounding to the Conex box using manufacturer "Seimens" material. The Seimens proposal was in the amount of \$46,577.00.

These proposals were rejected, based on the fact that the pricing on the two proposals submitted on August 14, 2012 was higher than what was budgeted for the work.

On August 20, 2012, an email was sent to Burden Electric requesting them to submit two new proposals, one for the Square D manufactured materials and one for the Seimens manufactured materials, but **removing** the grounding for the new tower and Conex box.


On August 27, 2012, Burden Electric submitted a proposal in the amount of \$48,568.50 using the "Square D" manufactured materials, and a proposal in the amount of \$42,601.50 using the "Seimens" manufactured materials. Both of these proposals had removed the grounding for the new tower and the Conex box.

Amendment No. 2 is being issued to clarify that the grounding for the new tower and the Conex box was **removed** from the Scope of Work that Burden Electric was contracted to provide when Gila County accepted Burden Electric's proposal for \$42,601.50.

All other terms and conditions of the original agreement shall remain in full force and affect during the term of the contract.
