SENATE BILL 1405

AN ACT

AMENDING SECTIONS 15-185 AND 15-901, ARIZONA REVISED STATUTES; AMENDING TITLE 15, CHAPTER 9, ARTICLE 1, ARIZONA REVISED STATUTES, BY ADDING SECTION 15-901.02; AMENDING SECTION 15-945, ARIZONA REVISED STATUTES; AMENDING TITLE 15, CHAPTER 9, ARTICLE 5, ARIZONA REVISED STATUTES, BY ADDING SECTION 15-980; AMENDING LAWS 2002, CHAPTER 330, SECTIONS 49 AND 51; MAKING APPROPRIATIONS; RELATING TO EDUCATION BUDGET RECONCILIATION.

4 Sec. 18. Joint legislative study committee; Hayden-Winkelman
5 property taxes

6 A. The joint legislative study committee on Hayden-Winkelman property
7 taxes is established consisting of the following members:

8 1. Three members of the senate who are appointed by the president of
9 the senate, including the chairperson of the senate appropriations committee
10 and the senator whose legislative district includes the Hayden-Winkelman
11 unified school district No. 41.

12 2. Three members of the house of representatives who are appointed by
13 the speaker of the house of representatives, including the chairperson of the
14 house of representatives appropriations committee and one member whose
15 legislative district includes the Hayden-Winkelman unified school district
16 No. 41.

17 3. One member who represents a statewide tax research organization and
18 who is appointed by the president of the senate.

19 4. One member who owns commercial real property in the
20 Hayden-Winkelman unified school district No. 41 and who is appointed by the
21 speaker of the house of representatives.

22 5. One member who is appointed by the president of the senate and who
23 represents a taxpayer that owns taxable property in the Hayden-Winkelman
24 unified school district No. 41 and in the town of Hayden that is valued by
25 the department of revenue pursuant to title 42, chapter 14, Arizona Revised
26 Statutes.

27 6. One member who is appointed by the speaker of the house of
28 representatives and who resides in and owns residential real property in the
29 Hayden-Winkelman unified school district No. 41.

30 7. One member of the governing body of the Hayden-Winkelman unified
31 school district No. 41 who is appointed by the president of the senate.

32 8. One member of the governing body of the town of Hayden who is
33 appointed by the speaker of the house of representatives.

34 9. One member who has expertise in public finance and investment
35 banking and who is appointed by the governor.

36 B. Members of the committee serve without compensation or
37 reimbursement of expenses. The committee shall select a chairperson from its
38 membership. The legislature shall provide meeting space and the joint
39 legislative budget committee shall provide staff support for the study
40 committee.

41 C. The study committee shall analyze the indebtedness, expenditures,
42 property taxes and other revenues of the Hayden-Winkelman unified school
43 district No. 41 and the town of Hayden and consider all possible solutions to
44 provide long-term relief and stability for the residents, property owners and
45 taxpayers of the community. The study committee shall submit a report of its
46 findings and recommendations to the president of the senate, the speaker of

1 the house of representatives and the governor on or before December 31, 2004
2 and shall provide a copy of this report to the secretary of state and the
3 director of the Arizona state library, archives and public records.

4 Sec. 19. Repeal

5 Section 18 of this act, relating to the joint legislative study
6 committee on Hayden-Winkelman property taxes, is repealed from and after
7 September 30, 2005.

8 Sec. 20. Publication

9 The publishers of the annotated Arizona Revised Statutes shall include
10 the text of section 17 of this act with the annotations under section 15-481,
11 Arizona Revised Statutes, through 2015.

12 Sec. 21. Retroactivity

13 A. Except as provided in subsection B of this section, this act
14 applies retroactively to from and after June 30, 2004.

15 B. Laws 2002, chapter 330, section 49, as amended by this act, applies
16 retroactively to from and after June 29, 2004.
