A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE EXECUTION OF AN INTERGOVERNMENTAL SERVICES AGREEMENT BETWEEN THE GILA COUNTY SHERIFF'S OFFICE AND THE TONTO APACHE TRIBE FOR COLLECTION OF INFORMATION REQUIRED UNDER TITLE 1 - SEX OFFENDER REGISTRATION AND NOTIFICATION ACT OF THE ADAM WALSH CHILD PROTECTION AND SAFETY ACT OF 2006

WHEREAS, Gila County and the Tonto Apache Tribe are jurisdictions which are required to implement Title I-Sex Offender Registration and Notification Act (SORNA) of the Adam Walsh Child Protection and Safety Act of 2006; and,

WHEREAS, the Gila County Sheriff's Office (GCSO) and the Tonto Apache Tribe (Tribe) are desirous of entering into a mutual agreement to cooperatively approach registration under SORNA, whereby the GCSO will provide certain registration services for offenders who are under the jurisdiction of the Tribe and who are required to register under SORNA ("Tribal Offenders"); and,

WHEREAS, the Intergovernmental Services Agreement between the GCSO and the Tribe requires each entity's governing body to adopt a resolution which authorizes the execution of the Intergovernmental Services Agreement.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Gila County Board of Supervisors hereby authorizes the execution of an Intergovernmental Services Agreement between the GCSO and the Tribe for collection of information required under Title 1-Sex Offender Registration and Notification Act of the Adam Walsh Child Protection and Safety Act of 2006.
