



**AMENDMENT NO. 2 TO PROFESSIONAL SERVICES CONTRACT NO. 042614-1**

The following amendments are hereby incorporated into the contract documents for the below stated project:

Effective June 24, 2014, Gila County and Michael B. Bernays entered into a contract whereby Michael B. Bernays agreed to provide Legal Services to the Superior Court in Gila County.

**Amendment No. 1 to Professional Services Contract No. 042614-1** was executed on September 17, 2014 to clarify and replace language contained in Section III-Compensation, Costs and Billing Procedures, and to clarify and replace language in C-1 Submission and Payment.

**Professional Services Contract No. 042614-1** was issued for a not to exceed, without advance written authorization, amount of \$92,076.00.


**Amendment No. 2 to Professional Services Contract No. 042614-1** is being issued to request an addition to the contract scope in the amount of One Thousand Five Hundred and no/dollars (\$1,500.00), *if needed during the remainder of the term of the contract*, to facilitate payment for legal services relating to indigent dependency representation.

Consequently, the contract is amended to increase the contract amount by \$1,500.00 for a new total contract amount of Ninety Three Thousand Five Hundred Seventy-Six dollars and 00/100's (\$93,576.00).

All other terms and conditions of the original contract shall remain in full force and affect during the July 1, 2014 to June 30, 2015 term of the contract.
