The Board of Supervisors convened in Regular Meeting at 9:00 A.M., May 5, 1980. Those present were: Lynn M. Sheppard, Chairman; Adolph B. Trujillo, Vice-Chairman; Robert P. Casillas, Member; Joe Albo, Legal Counsel; and Rose Marie Phillips, Clerk.

Donna Brumagin extended an invitation to the Board to participate with the St. Paul's Methodist Church of Globe in its Centennial Celebration this week.

Jerry DeRose joined the meeting as Legal Counsel and Joe Albo was excused.

Stan Parker, County Superintendent of Streets, submitted a Petition for abandonment of a certain portion of First Street in Midland City. After consideration, Supervisor Trujillo moved that the Clerk be instructed to publish a Notice of Intent to Abandon, setting the time and date as 10:00 A.M., May 27, 1980, for a Hearing on said matter. Supervisor Casillas seconded the motion that passed unanimously.

The Chairman advised the Board he had approved Notary Public Bonds for Barbara R. Dale and Debra Joanne Thompson.

It having been advertised, the Board considered the Z-2-80 Charles Blom (#10 Scott Ave., Central Heights) requested rezoning from R1-D6 to C-2. After discussion, by motion of Supervisor Trujillo, seconded by Supervisor Casillas, the Board unanimously approved said rezoning request as recommended by the County Planning and Zoning Commission.

Mrs. Treible, Secretary, and Mr. Jim Ellis, President, of the Community Food Bank, presented a request for financial assistance for the Bank in addition to the rent and utilities now being furnished by the County. The Board expressed its appreciation of the work being done by the Food Bank, but told them the request would have to be taken under advisement because of the shortage of funds being experienced by the County at this time. The Board indicated that, if possible, the County will be glad to give some assistance.

By unanimous motion the Board approved the schedule of events at the County Fairgrounds.

Upon motion of Supervisor Trujillo, seconded by Supervisor Casillas, the Board unanimously approved the Finance Director's Report of \$11,175.65 disbursed by Claims Nos. 11973 thru 12075 for amounts not over \$500.00 paid during the period of April 21, 1980, to April 28, 1980, inclusive.

By motion of Supervisor Trujillo, seconded by Supervisor Casillas, the Board unanimously approved for payment the following listed, audited Demands against Gila County:

Supervisor Trujillo moved approval of Minutes of the April 28, 1980, Board Meeting. Supervisor Casillas seconded said motion, which carried unanimously.

At this time the Board of Supervisors recessed their meeting as Supervisors, and convened as the Board of Equalization. In accordance with prearranged appointments, the Board gave consideration to the hereinafter listed requests and took action as indicated:

Parcel No. 208-03-059 -- By motion of Supervisor Trujillo, seconded by Supervisor Casillas, the Board unanimously left value of land the same and changed value of improvements to \$50,361.00.

Parcel No. 206-09-030 -- By motion of Supervisor Casillas, seconded by Supervisor Trujillo, the Board unanimously left value of land the same and changed value of improvements to \$300.00.

Parcel No. 101-07-314 -- By unanimous motion the Board left unchanged land and improvement values.

Parcel No. 206-20-002 -- By motion of Supervisor Trujillo, seconded by Supervisor Casillas, the Board unanimously changed value of land to \$600.00 and changed value of improvements to \$500.00.

Parcel No. 304-16-214A -- By motion of Supervisor Sheppard, seconded by Supervisor Casillas, the Board unanimously left value of land the same and changed value of improvements to \$5,000.00.

Parcel No. 305-12-021 -- By motion of Supervisor Sheppard, seconded by Supervisor Trujillo, the Board unanimously changed the value of the land to \$8,400.00.

Parcel No. 208-05-030 -- By motion of Supervisor Trujillo, seconded by Supervisor Casillas, the Board unanimously left value of land the same and changed value of improvements to \$37,117.00.

Parcel No. 203-15-005C2 -- The County Assessor's Office advised the Board that this particular parcel is no longer in existence.

There being no other protests to be heard at this time, the Board of Equalization closed its meeting.

The Supervisors now reconvened as the Board of Supervisors and continued to care for County business.

Van Wilson, Gila County Agricultural Agent, presented a proposed Budget for the Gila County Extension Service for the Board's consideration.

By unanimous motion the Board approved changes in the Tax Rolls as requested by the County Assessor in Resolutions Nos. 475 thru 483, T-693 thru T-753, and T-758.

William Tiffit and Captain Ken Daneker of the Salvation Army requested the Board to proclaim a Salvation Army Week for Gila County. Thereupon, by motion of Supervisor Trujillo, seconded by Supervisor Casillas, and made unanimous by Chairman Sheppard, the Board declared the Week of May 12 thru May 18, 1980, as Gila County Salvation Army Week and authorized the Chairman and Clerk to sign a Proclamation evidencing such Board action.

In accordance with Arizona Revised Statutes, by motion of Supervisor Trujillo, seconded by Supervisor Casillas, the Board unanimously appointed election workers and approved precinct polling places for the Special Tax Reform Election to be held June 3, 1980, and authorized a separate publication of details of such workers and polling places.

Upon motion of Chairman Sheppard, seconded by Supervisor Trujillo, the Board unanimously approved Resolution No. 80-5-1 extending benefits of the Homemakers Service Contract into the Payson Area.

#### RESOLUTION RELATIVE TO TITLE XX CONTRACT-- HOMEMAKERS SERVICE--CONTRACT AMENDMENT

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED That the Board acknowledges that the original agreement relative to the herein mentioned Contract will remain in full force and effect as to all other provisions.
